



FROM ASYLUM TO ASYLUM!

Have you ever been so persecuted for your faith that you were sent to an asylum? This month I have an amazing testimony from one of our students, "Sam", in CBC Hong Kong who has gone from one asylum to another! Sam shares this testimony:

"I am from a country in central Africa. When I was 16 years old, a friend explained Jesus to me in a way that I had never known before. God revealed Himself to me so personally that day!"

"I left the church singing and dancing in the love of God. The change was so apparent and my joy was so overwhelming that my parents literally thought that I had gone crazy. They placed me in an insane asylum where I was chained and drugged for two years. When I got out of the asylum I was not allowed to finish high school."

"I wasn't singing and dancing anymore, but my faith in God was still quietly strong. I went to work with my uncle. He took trips to Hong Kong and after relaying stories, I thought to myself, 'I will go to Hong Kong; that will be a way out for me.'"

"I purchased a friend's identity in order to get travel papers to Hong Kong! After arriving here, I went to the authorities seeking asylum. When they asked me why I wanted asylum, I knew the truth about my identity but didn't think it would get me anywhere, so I made something up!"

This CBC Student gave “Sam” the answers he was searching for years to find!



“Then I met a woman (another current CBC student) who suggested that I listen to some teachings by Andrew Wommack. After listening to a few teachings, I realized that Andrew had a similar experience to mine on March 23rd, 1968! I was not crazy! God was with me as He had always been!”

“I went back to the authorities and told them the truth about my situation. They told me that I now had sufficient grounds to apply for asylum! During the time I was seeking God, God was making a way. The laws changed and because of what my family did to me, I now have a case to stay in Hong Kong!”

Amazing testimony, right? Sam recently took an intelligence test to see if he can take another exam somewhat like our GED in the U.S.! I know that his results will be great! **Please pray for him as he seeks God and looks for a new home where he can be free to sing and dance in God’s love without persecution!**

This is one of the many reasons you are providing the way for me to be here in Hong Kong. **I love and thank YOU for sending me (and so does Sam)!**
